

CAMPUS PARKING

LOST and FOUND

SAFETY ESCORT PROGRAM

The Safety Escort Program is available to all students and staff at any time of the day or night. Contact any Campus Safety and Security Officer or call on the campus main security line (first slide) for a safety escort on campus. Do not hesitate to ask for a safety escort if a situation makes you feel afraid or threatened. Any reason is a legitimate reason to request a safety escort.



MOTORIST ASSISTANCE



The Campus Safety and Security Department offers jump-starts for vehicles with dead batteries, help with changing a flat tire, or assist you in calling "AAA" or a local tow service. The Department is not allowed to assist in unlocking your vehicle for any reason.
