The Cost of Attendance (COA) is an estimate of the cost of attending RVU and maintaining a modest but adequate standard of living. Your individual budget may be higher or lower. Books and supplies cost includes an OMM table and the iClicker; Also included in OMS II is an additional \$2,000 for board prep material. The COA does not include living expenses for a student's spouse or other dependents. Total loan amounts borrowed and scholarships awarded cannot exceed the COA minus any other aid received.
